



**The partnership between Opera Theatre of Northern Virginia and Teatro de la Luna is a natural.** Opera Theatre has a long history of introducing its audiences to music they have not heard before, but very limited experience in presenting works in Spanish. When the company decided to present *Bohemios*, it immediately sought the involvement of Teatro de la Luna, a leading producer of Spanish-language theater. Opera Theatre’s artistic director/conductor, John Edward Niles, is the musical director for *Bohemios*, and Mario Marcel, Teatro de la Luna’s artistic director, is the stage director and language coach.

The cast features **Lisa Archibeque** (soprano, Cossette), **Álvaro Rodríguez** (tenor, Roberto), **Pablo Henrich** (tenor, Victor), and **Rayanne Gonzales** (soprano, Pelagia). Adult and children’s choruses complete the cast. Performances are at Gunston Arts Center, Theatre One, 2700 S. Lang Street in Arlington, on February 23 and 24 at 8:00 pm, February 25, at 3:00 pm, March 2 and 3 at 8:00 pm, and March 4 at 3:00 pm. A guest moderator will lead a post-performance discussion of the work in the theater on February 23 and March 2 (Friday evenings).
