Lang St. in Arlington. Teatro de la Luna is delighted to announce that Mr. Rovner is coming from Argentina to attend opening weekend performances.

About the Play: With the title taken from a well-known tango, the show’s protagonist is a promising youth, who could be a surgeon or concert violinist. Instead he’s a podiatrist and member of a tango quartet. His dead mother, whom only he can see and hear, is determined he live up to his promises. Love and Laughter, two potent allies, hasten the inevitable!

About the Author: Playwright and director, Eduardo Rovner's awards include New York's *ACE* and *HOLA*, Uruguay's *Florencio* and Buenos Aires' *Municipal*, among many others. Author of over 35 plays which have been translated into many languages, Mr. Rovner's works have been published in five volumes by Editorial De la Flor, and by various international publishers. His plays have been staged in Argentina, Australia, Austria, Brazil, the Czech Republic, Colombia, Costa Rica, Cuba, Finland, Israel, Mexico, Paraguay, Peru, Puerto Rico, Spain, the U.S. and Uruguay. He has held positions in various theaters. He also teaches Drama and Theory.

About the Director: Mario Marcel is a director, actor, teacher and co-founder of Teatro de la Luna. He has directed innumerable productions, and has dedicated his life to promoting Hispanic culture. With a solid and outstanding artistic résumé in our community, he is also well-known throughout South and Central America. He has directed, adapted and acted in plays of all styles and traditions of the worldwide repertory. Mr. Marcel has received numerous awards and prizes for his works, both here and in South America.
