I Call Her Rusita Rojas makes a new—and charming—visit to the children’s classic, “Little Red Riding Hood.” In this version, a clever detective investigates the disappearance of a wolf. His only witness is Rusita, a talkative daydreamer. Under the direction of Jacqueline Briceño, Miami performing arts troupe Teatro Double brings the Spanish-language play to the 15th International Festival of Hispanic Theater organized by Teatro de la Luna. The performance is the children’s offering at the annual festival.

The 15th International Festival of Hispanic Theater presents DC, Maryland and Northern Virginia audiences with the rare opportunity to see some of the best in Latin American and Spanish theater performed by award-winning actors and theater groups from Spanish-speaking countries. The ongoing festival runs through November 17 at Gunston Arts Center-Theater Two, 2700 S. Lang Street in Arlington.

Also performing on Saturday, at 3 p.m. and 8 p.m., is *Fragrances from the Past* (Agüita de Viejas) from Ecuador, with earlier shows on Thursday Nov. 1 and Friday, Nov. 2 at 8 p.m.
