With support from a grant from The Mayor's Office on Latino Affairs in the District of Columbia, nonprofit performing arts organization *Teatro de la Luna* is inviting students at Powell Elementary School to participate in free **Bilingual Theater Workshops**. The workshops will take place at *Casa de la Luna*, 4020 Georgia Avenue, NW, Washington, DC 20011 (near the Georgia Ave/Petworth Metro station on the Green Line and in the same neighborhood as the Powell school).

The workshops take place over six Saturdays—April 27; May 4, 11, 18, 25; and June 1—from 9:30 to 11:30 a.m. Students who complete the workshops will show what they have learned on Monday, June 3, during an artistic presentation for parents, teachers and Powell students.

The theater workshops are the second in a series. Students from Bruce-Monroe Elementary School @ Park View participated in the first round in December 2012 and January 2013.

Since 1991, Teatro de la Luna has worked to promote Hispanic culture and foster cross-cultural understanding between the DC area's Spanish- and English-speaking communities. In addition to its educational Experience Theater Program, Teatro de la Luna hosts the annual International Festival of Hispanic Theater, produces plays showcasing local actors, offers play readings in Spanish, organizes an annual Spanish poetry marathon and presents musical events.
