Workshops will take place at Casa de la Luna, 4020 Georgia Avenue, NW, Washington, DC, just a few short blocks from the Georgia Avenue/Petworth Metro Station on the Green Line.

Workshops are geared for 6-11 year olds who want to explore the world of theater and develop skills in improvisation, theater games, singing, dancing, puppet making, playacting and characterization while working on improving their Spanish.
