Teatro de la Luna presents **Children’s Theater Festival**

Six hours of family fun are on the agenda Saturday, January 18, when **Teatro de la Luna** hosts its annual **Children’s Theater Festival**. Highlights of this year’s festival at the Rosslyn Spectrum Theater include family-focused theater and folkloric dance presentations showcasing troupes from Paraguay, Bolivia, Mexico and Peru. **All activities are BILINGUAL.**

Beginning at **11 am**, the lobby of the Spectrum will be transformed into an activity area where children can color, draw, sing and read, sharing their own talents with their peers and parents.

At **noon**, Teatro de la Luna’s newest show for children, **Happy and Healthy** written and directed by Neher J. Briceño, will be performed.

The performance is followed by a lunch break. At **2 pm** the ‘Kids on Stage’ performances begin. They feature **Tobas Dinastía** (*Bolivian folklore dance*); **Los Quetzales** (*Mexican folklore dance*); **Escuela de Danzas Peruanas Matices** (*Marineras Norteñas folklore dance from Peru*); **Ballet Folklórico Paraguayo ‘Ko’etî** (*‘Dawn’ Paraguayan Folkloric Ballet*); and **‘Las Lunitas’**, the children participating in Teatro de la Luna’s Saturday theater workshops.

Lobby activities continue following those performances. At **4 pm**, La Luna presents a second performance of *Happy and Healthy*.

Throughout the Festival, food and drinks will be available for purchase in the lobby. Books and crafts will also be on sale.

Rosslyn Spectrum Theater is two blocks from the Rosslyn Metro Station on the Blue and Orange lines. Ample free parking under the building is accessed from Arlington Ridge Road. For more information, visit www.teatrodelaluna.org
