To celebrate its Silver Anniversary, Teatro de la Luna is launching ‘**THURSDAYS AT LA LUNA**,’ a showcase of videos of its best stage performances over the last 25 years. The evening screenings are designed to bring people together to see and discuss past performances and their highlights.

The screenings will be held monthly at 7 p.m. at Casa de la Luna (4020 Georgia Ave., NW, Washington DC, 20011), conveniently located not far from the Georgia Avenue-Petworth Metro; there is also a Metro bus stop right in front of the venue. Street parking is free in the evenings.

The inaugural screening, on Sept. 3, will be the play **El Día que me Quieras** (*The Day You Love Me*) by the great Venezuelan playwright José Ignacio Cabrujas and directed by La Luna’s Mario Marcel. The play features actors Hugo Reale, Javier Teran, Vera Soltero, Carmen Parejo Medina, Jorge Borges, Aníbal Bogliacini and Nucky Walder. The work brings to the stage two legends: Gardel and Lenin. One is the smiling idol of weightless being, the other is a harsh agent of social change.

Other productions that will be screened at future Thursdays at la Luna include: *Venecia/Venice*; *Las Quiero a las Dos/I Want Them Both*; *FRIDA Kahlo, la Pasión/FRIDA Kahlo, The Passion*; *Cuentos de Hadas/Fairy Tales*; *Volvió una Noche/She Returned One Night*; *Tango Turco/Turkish Tango*; *Rosa de Dos Aromas/Two-Scented Rose*; *Amor al Aire Libre/Love in the Open Air*; and *Justo en lo mejor de mi vida/Just at Life’s Best Moment*.

The events are free but space is limited. Donations are accepted. There will be refreshments for sale.
