Teatro de la Luna, founded in 1991, continues producing theater and other cultural events that spotlight and celebrate Latin American culture. The organization has been recognized for its cultural contributions on several occasions. In acknowledgement of the work of its director, Mario Marcel, it received the *Elizabeth Campbell Award* for advancement of the arts from the American Association of University Women's Arlington chapter. On two occasions, La Luna was honored with the STAR prize from the Arlington County Commission for the Arts for administrative excellence and service to the community, and La Luna's producer, Nucky Walder, was honored with the *Latina Woman Leadership 2009* award.

The goal of building connections between the Spanish-speaking and English-speaking communities is achieved by promoting dialogue and community involvement through bilingual and translated theatrical and cultural events.
